Definitions

Defense Worker: An individual employed by a Pennsylvania defense supplier who is currently directly working on a DoD Contract
**Excludes: Active Duty Personnel, Civilian Service, R&D at PA Institution of Higher Ed, Veteran*

Allowable expenses: Funds may only go towards the delivery of training services, not directly towards tuitions or certifications for workers

Defense Worker "Qualified" for assistance through DoD OEA Grant

Check Eligibility:

1. Defense worker is or was employed by a Pennsylvania defense supplier *(must be yes)*
2. Worker(s) have been negatively impacted, displaced or relocated due to company cutbacks from loss or reduction of DoD contract *(must be yes)*

- 2a. Worker is still employed but may be underemployed or may have been moved from a DoD-related production line to another line due to spending cuts or loss of DoD contract
